AUTHORIZATION FOR TREATMENT OF MINOR

I, the undersigned, understand and acknowledge that reasonable efforts will be made to contact the parents in case of an emergency, and, if possible, before any medical treatment is administered. I understand that I may be responsible for all costs associated with the provision of emergency medical services or treatment.

WorldStrides cannot be responsible for accommodating any food allergies, requirements or restrictions and is not responsible for any problems associated with the same. All issues with regard to food and drink, including allergies, requirements and restrictions are the sole responsibility of the participant.

In the event of any emergencies during the trip, the undersigned hereby grants authority to be exercised at the discretion of the Program Leader or chaperone to dispense over-the-counter medication.

Student Code of Conduct

The WorldStrides experience you have elected to attend offers many unique opportunities and experiences. Beyond the educational benefits, the program offers opportunities to form new friendships and to meet the challenges of independence. As a student participant, it is your responsibility to help make the program a positive and enjoyable experience for everyone. All participants are expected to demonstrate high standards of conduct, exhibit good judgment, act courteously, and show respect toward others.

Additionally, while participating on the program, the student is responsible for adhering to the following rules of behavior:

1. The student shall follow all directions given by and all rules and regulations established by the Program Leader and Chaperones.
2. The student shall remain with the group at all times, unless the Program Leader specifically allows free time in small groups. The student may never leave the hotel unless accompanied by a Program Leader or Chaperone.
3. The student shall not engage in smoking, vaping of any kind, illegal drugs, vandalism, theft, gambling or any other type of behavior that is judged by the Program Leader and/or Chaperones to be detrimental to the health, well-being, safety, or reputation of oneself or others.
4. The student shall not engage in alcohol consumption unless the student is of legal age and has approval from their parent/guardian and Program Leader.
5. Bullying, verbal or physical harassment, or inappropriate interactions with others will not be tolerated.
6. Any behavior resulting in engagement with local authorities will be the responsibility and expense of the student and their parent/guardian.
7. The student shall comply with all rules and regulations established by governmental agencies and service providers including but not limited to airlines, hotels, motorcoach companies, national parks, and national security.
8. Facilities (hotels, restaurants, motorcoaches) utilized and sites visited during the program should be left in the same condition in which they were found. Any property damage, theft, vandalism, unauthorized use, and copywrite violations are the sole responsibility of the student. If an incident occurs, the student and parent/guardian will be required to work directly with the provider to remedy the situation.
9. The student is solely responsible for keeping safe possession of all their belongings throughout the program. WorldStrides is not responsible for the replacement of any lost, stolen or damaged items while in transit or on the program.
10. The student is responsible for keeping safe possession of their travel documentation and government issued identification (passport, visa, green card).
11. Quiet hours at the hotel will be observed each evening (typically from 10pm until 6am).



12. The student must sleep in their assigned hotel room each night.
13. Good common sense, respect and consideration for others and their property should be practiced daily.

If the student violates any of these rules, they may be dismissed from the program at the sole discretion of the Program Leader and Chaperones. **In the case of dismissal, the parent/guardian will be contacted, and the student sent home at the expense of the parent/guardian without a refund.**

Adult Participant Code of Conduct

The WorldStrides program you have elected to attend offers many unique opportunities and experiences. Each Program is designed to provide an enriched educational experience for students. As an adult participant, you are in a unique position to help make the program a positive and enjoyable experience for yourself, the students, educators and other adult participants. WorldStrides expects all participants to demonstrate high standards of conduct, exhibit good judgment, act courteously, and show respect toward others.

1. The participant will follow all rules and regulations established by the Program Leader and Chaperones.
2. The participant agrees to follow the planned itinerary and to be punctual at all times.
3. In the event a participant on the program needs medical attention or is showing signs of distress, the participant will notify the Program Leader, Chaperone, and/or a member of the WorldStrides On-Tour Support Team and remain with the fellow participant until help is available.
4. The participant shall not engage in vandalism, theft, drug or alcohol distribution to minors, the use of illegal drugs, or any other behavior that is detrimental to the health, well-being, safety, or reputation of themselves or others.
5. In all situations where the adult participant chooses to consume alcoholic beverages, smoke, vape or engage in any other activity of an adult nature, they must do so outside the presence of minor students, at their own expense, and remain in full control of their behavior at all times.
6. The participant shall comply with all rules and regulations established by governmental agencies and service providers including but not limited to airlines, hotels, motorcoach companies, national parks, and national security.
7. Facilities (hotels, restaurants, motorcoaches) utilized and sites visited during the program should be left in the same condition in which they were found. Any consequences or costs associated with property damage, theft, vandalism, unauthorized use, or copyright violations are the sole responsibility of the participant.
8. Bullying, verbal and physical harassment, or inappropriate interactions with others will not be tolerated. To promote the well-being of all participants, if the participant observes, overhears, or suspects such behavior, they should report the behavior to the Program Leader, Chaperone, or member of the WorldStrides On-Tour Support Team.
9. Any behavior resulting in engagement with local authorities will be the responsibility and expense of the participant.

If a participant violates any of these rules, they may be dismissed from the program at the sole discretion of the Program Leader. **In the case of a dismissal the participant will be sent home at their expense without a refund.**
